

LIGHTING UP A BRIGHT **FUTURE**

Story of how a small family business scaled up to become the market leader in the lighting industry

Derek Wu is an engineerentrepreneur. After turned immersing himself in the I.T. industry for more than 10 years in the UK, he returned to Hong Kong to help with his uncle's small lighting family business. He then transformed the business from solely a small retail store into a lighting distributing empire Future Lighting within 10 years time, in which the business expanded its scope of offerings to include more projects and products distribution.

Expansion was no easy feat. The first step was to increase product offerings. Derek had to visit light exhibitions around the world to look for potential manufacturing brands well as set up distribution and project channels that follows the company's key concept or

direction - "Sell to more people, sell more to people." The objective of setting up project channels is "to put eggs in baskets." Contrary multiple to the distribution channels which focus on Businessto-Customers(B2C)services, project channels involve more Business-to-Business(B2B) services, through collaborations with interior designers, property developers and architects.
